

MCIU INTENSIVE AUTISTIC SUPPORT

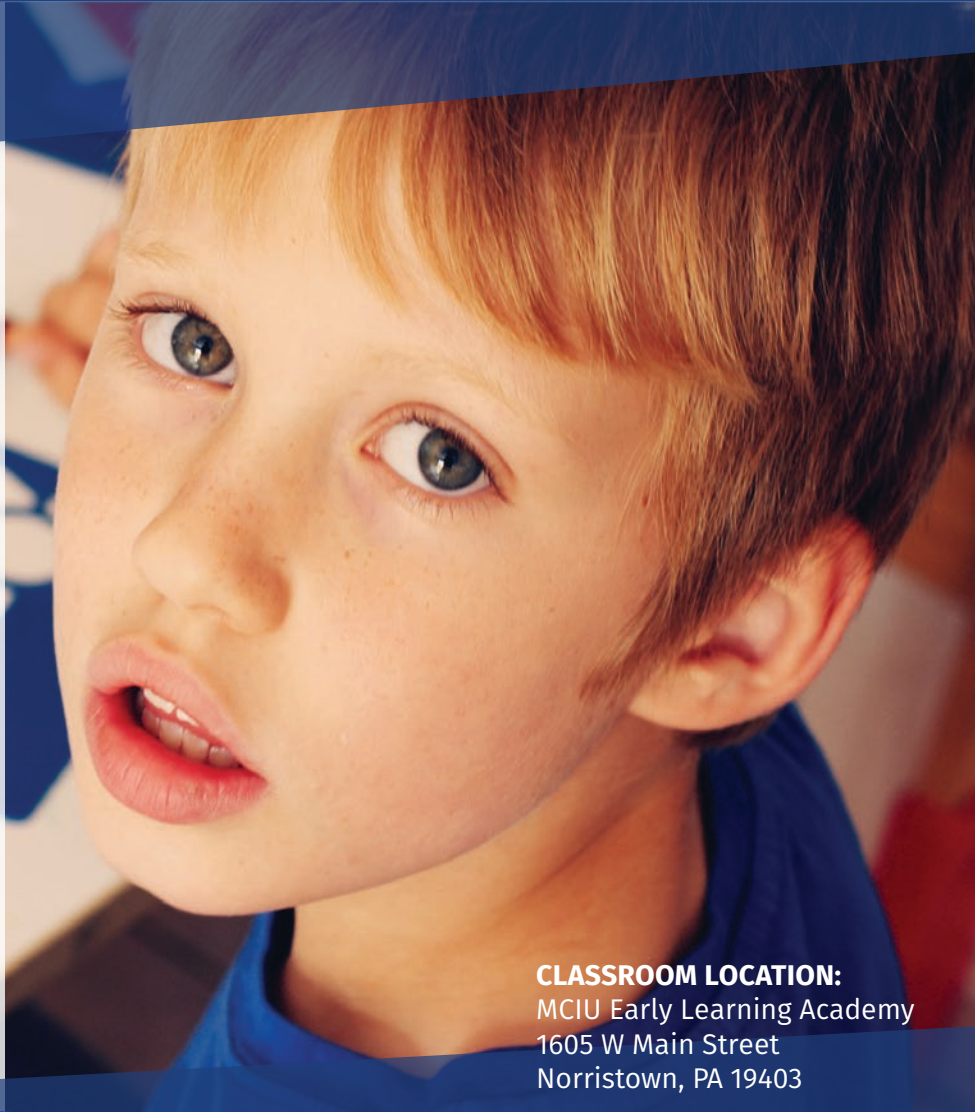
- Available for students in grades K-5

- Full-time Board Certified Behavior Analyst in the classroom daily
- Access to MCIU Social Workers to assist families with referrals and links to outside services needed to support children's development such as Intensive Behavioral Health Services, doctors, dentists, camp programs, etc.

A team of professionals will create an approach to learning that considers the most effective interventions, techniques and resources that are based on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis and unique to the needs of students diagnosed with autistic spectrum disorder.

The academic programming for every child includes a focus to develop verbal, academic and life skills by reducing significant problematic behaviors for positive outcomes. This includes application of appropriate social skills both inside the classroom and for transfer outside of the classroom with caregivers and in within the community.
